

#### **ABOUT INSPIRELI AWARDS**

The original idea of the competition came from President Vaclav Havel and Professor Bořek Šípek. The aim was to build a platform to help up-and-coming talents in architecture, regardless of their economic, social, or ethnic conditions.

Within three years of the project's launch, INSPIRELI AWARDS has developed into one of the World's largest student competitions.






Somayeh Ravanshad, Professor of the University of Architecture in Iran, was the best ambassador for Inspireli last year, and has been selected as a young juror for the competition.




Student Martin Hořešovský met the most prominent architect of Indonesia, Budi Pradono, and became a member of his team during the Venice Biennale.




#### THIS YEAR'S INSPIRELI COMPETITION IS EXTRAORDINARY!

The foundation of the stability of the whole is in the variety of its parts. The variety within the Inspireli Awards is one of its strengths.



**Otto Dvorak**, a member of the American Institute of Architects, has been a longtime professor at Harvard University and is currently one of the world's expert in architecture, urban planning, and conservation. His services are being used by leading home and world developers.

Successful entrepreneur and philanthropist **Karel Janeček** is the newest member of the core team. He provides software support and technology for evaluating modules within the project.



#### INSIDEOUT SCHOOL IN GHANA


Dear Francesca and Andrea,









Reconstruction of a family house








